Novamol Protect™



Presentation: White to off-white, free-flowing emollient gel.

Uses: Novamol Protect is an easy to apply free-flowing emollient gel with fire retardance properties. This means that clothing, bedding, dressings and bandages with Novamol Protect dried on them do not catch fire easily and do not burn more readily than fabrics without this emollient dried on them.

It is used for the management of dry skin, which may also be itchy. It can moisturise dry skin for up to 24 hours after one application by using a special combination of ingredients without the need for oils.

Directions: For use by adults and the elderly only. Apply once daily, or as often as needed to dry skin. Gently smooth the gel across the skin in the same direction as hair growth.

Contraindications, warnings, side effects etc: May cause temporary tingling, itching, or stinging. Regular use of emollients can help to restore the skin barrier, so these issues may reduce with continued use. People with known allergies should check the ingredients list before use. If a rash occurs, stop using this product. The skin may be more sensitive than normal to sunburn when using this product. Keep out of reach of children. **For optimal safety, always practice responsible behaviour. Do not smoke near flammable materials and always handle heat and flame sources with care.**

Ingredients: Aqua, urea (10%), sodium lactate, ethylhexylglycerin, polyacrylate crosspolymer-6, phenoxyethanol, lactic acid, glycerin, PVP (povidone), tocopherol and t-butyl alcohol.

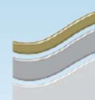
